**This Program will take place at the Remick Barn Visitors Center on the corner of York St and Lindsay Rd.**

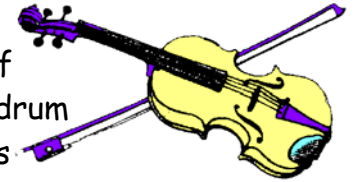


# May Day Celebration
